Competitor Selection

10 competitors will be selected from the submitted entries to move forward to compete for the 2023 Young Landscaper of the Year. During the week commencing **4th August**, entrants and their employers will be contacted by email to confirm if successful in progressing through to the finals.

Selection Process

In reviewing entrant submissions. Judges will consider attitude to work, maturity, personal development, and overall skills to identify competitors. They also consider the following:

- Work ethic
- Communication skills and personal presentation
- Ability to follow instructions
- Industry knowledge
- Ability to work unsupervised
- Understanding of work, health & safety practice
- Relationships with fellow workers, suppliers, and clients
- Training and study achievements

Competitors will be sent an information pack with the competitors' programme **3 weeks** prior to the competition day. The information pack will include a brief on a 3-minute speech topic to be prepared and then presented by the competitor at the event..Competitors will also be required to attend a zoom interview with judging panel
